O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On September 8, 1999, pursuant to Application No. C-2069, Rhythms Links, Inc. (Rhythms) of Englewood, Colorado was granted authority to obtain a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska.

By letter dated November 27, 2001, Rhythms has requested that its certificate be canceled. Rhythms filed for Chapter 11 Bankruptcy on August 1, 2001. Subsequent to those proceedings, no additional financing was obtained and discontinuance of service and cancellation of its certificates is necessary. Rhythms currently has no customers in the state of Nebraska.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the certificate of operating authority previously issued in Application No. C-2609 to Rhythms Links, Inc., be, and it is hereby, canceled.
