BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed March 17, 2004, Network Access Solutions Corporation (Network Access) of Herndon, Virginia, seeks to withdraw its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide local exchange and emerging competitive telecommunications service, previously granted by the Commission in Application No. C-2181. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 19, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On May 2, 2000, Network Access was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide local exchange and emerging competitive telecommunications service by the Commission, pursuant to Application No. C-2181.

By letter received on March 12, 2004, Network Access requested that their authority and certificate be withdrawn. Network Access filed Chapter 11 bankruptcy on June 4, 2002, and is no longer a business as of January 10, 2003.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Network Access's certificate and authority previously granted in Application No. C-2181 should be withdrawn.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3159 be, and it is hereby, granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide local exchange and emerging competitive telecommunications service granted to Network Access Solutions Corporation, is withdrawn.
