BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed November 18, 2004, MCI, Inc. (MCI) of Atlanta, Georgia, seeks cancellation of Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services and withdrawal of tariffs. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 19, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On March 4, 1997, MCI, was granted a Certificate of Authority to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Nebraska through its subsidiary, Intermedia Communications, Inc., pursuant to Application C-1420. On May 6, 1997, MCI was also granted a Certificate of Authority to provide local exchange service, pursuant to Application C-1450.

By letter received on November 18, 2004, MCI requested the withdrawal of its Certificates of Authority. MCI no longer has customers in Nebraska and does not intend to resell its telecommunications services in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that MCI's certificates of authority should be canceled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application C-3305 be, and it is hereby, granted and the Certificates of Authority previously granted to MCI, Inc., are canceled.
