O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By application filed November 18, 2004, MCI, Inc. (MCI) of Atlanta, Georgia, sought cancellation of Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services and withdrawal of tariffs. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on November 19, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application was processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

On January 4, 2005, in Application No. C-3305, the Commission entered an order granting the application. After issuing its order, MCI requested the Commission clarify the action taken in its January 4, 2005 order. For clarification purposes, on January 4, 2005, the Commission approved the withdrawal of two certificates issued in Dockets C-1420 and C-1450 which were held by Intermedia Communications, Inc. (Intermedia) a subsidiary of MCI, Inc.

After examining the record and being fully advised, the Commission finds that the record should be clarified to reflect the Commission's actions were to permit the withdrawal of certificate numbers C-1420 and C-1450 held by Intermedia. Accordingly, the Commission issues this order to clarify its January 4, 2005 Order.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the order entered on January 4, 2005, be and it is hereby clarified to reflect that the Commission permitted the voluntary withdrawal of certificate numbers C-1420 and C-1450 held by Intermedia Communications, Inc.
