By application filed August 15, 2005, KMC Telecom III, LLC (KMC), Lawrenceville, Georgia, seeks to withdraw its authority as a competitive local exchange and interexchange telecommunications carrier in the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application appeared in The Daily Record on August 19, 2005.

KMC was granted authority to operate as a competitive local exchange and interexchange telecommunications carrier in Nebraska in Application's C-2065 and C-2214 respectively. KMC has no customers in Nebraska; accordingly, the proposed discontinuance of service will not affect the provision of local or long distance services in Nebraska.

Upon review of the application and circumstances presented, the Commission is of the opinion that KMC's request should be honored and its certificates should be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application C-3466 be and it is hereby granted and the certificates of operating authority previously issued in Application C-2065 and C-2214 be cancelled.


