BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed July 3, 2006, KMC Telecom V, Inc. (KMC), of Bridgewater, New Jersey, seeks to withdraw its local exchange and interexchange authority of telecommunications services and cancel its tariffs in the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 13, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On September 12, 2000, KMC was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide competitive local exchange service on a combined resale and facilities basis and to provide resold interexchange service in Nebraska in Application No. C-2327.

By letter received on July 3, 2006, KMC requested the withdrawal of its Certificates of Authority and Tariffs within the state of Nebraska. KMC no longer has customers in Nebraska, has disbanded its leased network, and does not intend to resell its telecommunications services in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that KMC's certificates of authority and tariffs should be canceled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3662 be, and it is hereby, granted and the Certificates of Authority and Tariffs previously granted to KMC Telecom V, Inc., are canceled.


