By application filed July 19, 2007, New Access Communications LLC, (New Access), of Minneapolis, Minnesota, seeks to withdraw their interexchange authority of telecommunications services and cancel its tariffs in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on July 20, 2007. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By letter received on July 19, 2007, New Access requested the withdrawal of its Certificates of Authority and Tariffs within the state of Nebraska. New Access no longer has customers in Nebraska due to the sale of substantially all of its assets to First Communications, LLC, Garfield Heights, Ohio.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that New Access's certificates of authority and tariffs should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3843 be, and it is hereby, granted and the Certificates of Authority and Tariffs previously granted to New Access Communications LLC, are canceled.
