PRELIMINARY MATTERS

By application filed September 12, 1994, Eastern Ambulance Service, Inc. (Eastern) of Lincoln, Nebraska seeks authority to transfer ownership to Rural Metro Corporation of Scottsdale, Arizona. Notice of the application was published in the Omaha Daily Record on September 14, 1994 pursuant to the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protests were received; therefore, we process this application by the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure (see Title 291 NAC Ch. 1, Rule 018.03).

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Eastern Ambulance Service, Inc. obtained a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in March, 1991, in Application No. C-866. Since certification, no formal complaints or departmental complaints have been filed against the company.

If this application is granted, Eastern Ambulance will transfer ownership from Marty Miller, Russ Bayer and Mike Dodge to Rural Metro Corporation. The transfer of ownership will not affect the company's operating practices, personnel, quality of service or rates. Granting this application will have no affect on the ability of the company to provide reasonable and adequate service throughout Nebraska.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-1108 be, and it is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall continue to file, in accordance with the applicable statutes, an annual report with this Commission consisting of (a) a copy of any report filed with the Federal Communications Commission, (b) the annual report to stockholders, and (c) for the state of Nebraska on a combined interstate - intrastate basis, the investment, if any, in telephone plant and equipment located
