BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 21, 2000, the Commission opened this docket for the purpose of investigating the issues and decisions necessary for implementation of wholesale service performance standards for incumbent local exchange carriers (ILECs). Public notice of this docket was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 23, 2000. Interested parties were directed to file initial comments by April 12, 2000. Interested parties were then provided an opportunity to file reply comments by April 27, 2000.

O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

Pursuant to the Commission's order dated March 20, 2001, each incumbent local exchange carrier was to develop an individualized wholesale service quality performance plan consistent with the Commission's findings and conclusions outlined in the order.

To date, the Commission has approved the plans of Alltel, Citizens and Qwest. Sprint has filed their plan with the Commission and it will be addressed under Application No. C-2824.

Furthermore, the Commission will approve the remainder of the local exchange carrier (LEC) plans according to the policy set forth in Application No. C-2248/PI-37, as they are filed with the Commission. Therefore, the Commission is of the opinion that Application No. C-2248/PI-37 should be closed at this time.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2248/PI-37 be, and is hereby, closed.
