On December 20, 2002, an application was filed by Concert Communications Sales, L.L.C. (Concert) of Reston, Virginia, seeking authority to change its name to BT Communications Sales, L.L.C. Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 26, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Concert is a Delaware corporation with its headquarters in Reston, Virginia. Concert was authorized by this Commission to operate as a resale carrier of telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska on June 15, 1999, pursuant to Application No. C-2025.

In its current application, Concert asks the Commission to grant a name change. Due to business considerations, Concert has changed its name to BT Communications Sales L.L.C. A copy of the company's amended certificate of authority issued by the Secretary of State is enclosed with the application.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion that the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-2850 be, and it is hereby, granted and Concert Communications Sales, L.L.C. is authorized to change its name to BT Communications Sales L.L.C.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant file an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
