On February 25, 2004, the Commission directed parties to work with each other to resolve or eliminate as many of the discovery objections as possible and resubmit to the Commission, on or before March 17, 2004, any Discovery objections that remain outstanding.

On March 17, Cox Communications submitted a request for additional time for all parties to file revised objections to discovery.

In consideration of this request and other matters, a limited extension is therefore granted. Parties will have until April 2, 2004, to submit to the Commission any Discovery objections that remain outstanding. Parties are encouraged to use this additional time judiciously to resolve as many objections as possible.

Once the Commission has had the opportunity to review any unresolved objections, an order will be entered ruling on the discovery issues and setting forth a revised timeline under which the Commission will move forward with its TRO review.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Hearing Officer that the deadline for filing any unresolved discovery objections is hereby extended until April 2, 2004.


