BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed March 18, 2004, Qwest Communications, Inc., (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado seeks authority to adjust depreciation rates on classes of its equipment. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 4, 2004. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Qwest submits the present application in accordance with the Commission's order of April 14, 1987, in Application No. C-664. Pursuant to that order, Qwest is subject to a depreciation rate review on a triennial basis.

Qwest submitted revised depreciation rates in accordance with its triennial obligations. The revised rates will decrease annual depreciation costs by \$31,151,000 or 24.6 percent and will more closely correlate accrual rates with capital asset consumption. A summary of the revised rates is attached to this order as Exhibit A.

Based on the evidence presented, the Commission finds the application is fair and reasonable and in the public interest. The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3148 be, and it is hereby, granted and Qwest Communications, Inc. is hereby authorized to adjust its depreciation rates as reflected in Exhibit A, attached to and, hereby, made a part of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the revised depreciation rates be effective retroactively beginning January 1, 2004.
