BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 23, 2004, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) entered an order in this docket revoking the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued to several defendants, including Group Long Distance, Inc. (Group) due to the failure to timely file annual reports pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-159 (2002 Cum. Supp.).

The Commission subsequently determined that Group had in fact submitted its annual report, a signed stipulation and the agreed fine amount prior to the November 23, 2004 order. Group should have been dismissed from the docket. However, due to a clerical oversight, Group was listed with the defendants remaining in the docket and as a result its authority was revoked in the November 23, 2004 order. Subsequently, the Commission entered an order on December 14, 2004 closing the present docket.

The stipulation and fine amount submitted by Group was satisfactory. In order to correct the fact that Group was inadvertently included in the list of defendants whose Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity were revoked, the Commission reopens the present docket for the sole purpose of reinstating the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously issued to Group Long Distance, Inc.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Docket C-3213/DC-67, be, and is hereby, reopened for the sole purpose of reinstating the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued to Group Long Distance, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued to Group Long Distance, Inc. shall be and is hereby reinstated.


