In the current application, Z-Tel seeks to operate this authority under the name Trinsic Communications, Inc. Z-Tel received authorization from the Secretary of State to change its name in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.
