On March 25, 2005, WorldxChange Corporation (WorldxChange Bell or Applicant) San Diego, California, filed an application seeking to change its name to Acceris Communications Corp. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 14, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Pursuant to Application C-2346, this Commission authorized applicant, operating under the name PT-1 Counsel, Inc., to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska. Pursuant to Application C-2803, this Commission authorized PT-1 Counsel, Inc. to change the name of its operating authority to WorldxChange Corporation.

In the current application, Applicant seeks to operate this authority under the name Acceris Communications Corp. Applicant received authorization from the Secretary of State to change its name in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application C-3402 be, and it is hereby, granted and WorldxChange Corporation be, and it is hereby authorized to change its name to Acceris Communications Corp.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant filed an updated tariff reflecting the change in name within 30 days of the date of this order.
