O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On July 5, 2005, the Commission held a prehearing conference in the above-captioned matter. Appearances were entered by the following: Jim Overcash, Paul Schudel, Tim Clare, Dan Klaus and Troy Kirk for the 34 applicants. Steve Seglin appeared for the Formal Intervenor, WWC Licensing LLC. The applicants and the Intervenor are collectively referred to in this order as "the parties."

Paul Schudel explained the reasons underlying the application submitted by the 34 applicants. The applicants are seeking relief from the Commission's July 2004 Intermodal LNP Order requiring the applicants to file an application by July 20, 2005, if a second suspension was sought. Steve Seglin argued that the Commission did not have jurisdiction to modify the July 20, 2005 deadline as requested. The parties agreed that there are no facts in dispute and that the Commission could render its decision based on the legal arguments presented in the pleadings and supporting briefs.

Accordingly, at the prehearing conference the parties agreed to the following deadlines:
