PNG was authorized by this Commission to operate as a interexchange carrier on June 13, 1995, pursuant to Application C-1151.

In its current application, PNG seeks to change its name to CrossConnect. This transaction will be transparent to its customers and will result in no change in the rates, terms and conditions in which its customers will receive service. Customers will be notified of the change in name.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.
