BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 18, 2005, an application was filed by MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. (MCI WorldCom), Denver, Colorado, seeking to change its name to MCI Communications Services, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 2, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On October 31, 2003, MCI (f/k/a WorldCom, Inc.) and 221 of its direct and indirect domestic subsidiaries emerged from Chapter 11 bankruptcy proceedings. The name changes are part of MCI's continuing effort to simplify its corporate legal structure and should help prevent confusion in MCI's dealings with regulators and customers.

In its current application, MCI WorldCom seeks to change its name to MCI Communications Services, Inc. This transaction will be transparent to its customers and will result in no change in the rates, terms and conditions in which its customers will receive service. Customers will be notified of the change in name.

Upon consideration of the application, the governing statutes and rules, and being fully informed, the Commission is of the opinion the application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application C-3471 be, and it is hereby, granted and MCI WorldCom Communications Inc. is authorized to change its name to MCI Communications Services, Inc.
