BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 16, 2005, a joint application was filed by Advantage Telecommunications, Corp. (ATC) and Sonya Bly both of Winter Park, Florida, seeking authority to transfer control of stock in ATC to Robert Sorrentino of Burlington, New Jersey. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 20, 2005. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

ATC is a Delaware corporation with its principle office in Winter Park, Florida. ATC is authorized to provide interstate and international long distance telecommunications services in all 50 states. ATC received authority to provide long distance services in Nebraska pursuant to Commission Order No. C-1989.

Bly is an individual whose business address is in Winter Park, Florida. Bly currently holds 100 percent of the stock interest in ATC. Sorrentino is also an individual whose business address is in Burlington, New Jersey. Neither Bly nor Sorrentino hold a certificate of authority.

Pursuant to the proposed transaction, Sorrentino will acquire all of Bly's stock in ATC. ATC will continue to provide competitive telecommunications services to its existing customers using the same technical and managerial personnel following consummation of the proposed transaction. The proposed transfer of control will be seamless to ATC's customers; its name, rates, and service offerings will not change as a result of the proposed transaction.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application C-3516, be, and it is hereby, granted.




