Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 22, 2006. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant is a corporation created and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, with its principal office located Overland Park, Kansas. Applicant is a certified competitive telecommunications carrier providing intrastate and interstate telecommunications. The applicant was granted authority by this Commission to provide local exchange and interexchange services under Application No. C-1386.

In the present application, Applicant seeks authorization to change its trade name from Sprint to Embarq. United Telephone Company of the West has received authority from the Secretary of State of Nebraska to change its trade name. The name change will have no impact on customers or services. Customers have been provided notice of the name change via written communications.
