Applicant was granted authority to provide intrastate telecommunications services in Nebraska pursuant to Application No. C-1883. CTC provides integrated full-service telecommunications services.

In the present application, Applicant seeks authorization to adopt the d/b/a name One Communications. The d/b/a name will have no impact on customers, services or corporate structure of CTC.
