BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 9, 2007, an application was filed by Working Assets Funding Service, Inc. d/b/a Working Assets Long Distance ("Working" or "Applicant"), of San Francisco, California, seeking to change its name to Working Assets Funding Service, Inc. d/b/a Credo Long Distance. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 10, 2007. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

Working is a corporation formed under the laws of the State of California with its principal place of business in San Francisco, California. Applicant was granted authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services in Nebraska pursuant to Docket C-965 on May 24, 1993.

In the present application, Applicant seeks authorization to change its trade name from Working Assets Long Distance to Credo Long Distance. The new name will have no impact on customers, services or corporate structure of Working. Applicant states it will file a tariff reflecting the new name and the new address once Commission approval of the name change has been received.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3867 be, and it is hereby, granted and Working Assets Funding Service, Inc. d/b/a Working Assets Long Distance, is authorized to change its name to Working Assets Funding Service, Inc. d/b/a Credo Long Distance.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an updated tariff reflecting the change in name and address be filed with the Commission accordingly.


