BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 30, 2008, an application was filed by Network Communications International Corp. a/k/a Mundo Telecom, also a/k/a 1800Call4Less ("Network" or "Applicant"), of Longview, Texas, seeking a name change to remove its trade name Mundo Telecom. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 5, 2008. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Network was authorized to operate as a local exchange and interexchange carrier of telecommunications services within the state of Nebraska by the Commission on November 24, 1998, pursuant to Docket C-1915. In the current application, Network wishes to remove the trade name Mundo Telecom. Network filed the necessary paperwork to remove the trade name with the Secretary of State of Nebraska.

The name change will have no impact on customers, services or corporate structure of Network. Network states it will file a tariff reflecting the new name once Commission approval of the name change has been received.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-3928 be, and it is hereby, granted and Network Communications International Corp. a/k/a Mundo Telecom, also a/k/a 1800Call4Less, is authorized to change its name to Network Communications International Corp. and also 1800Call4Less.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an updated tariff reflecting the change in name be filed with the Commission accordingly.
