On December 23, 2008, an application was filed by Huntel Cablevision, Inc. ("Huntel") of Blair, seeking authority to do business as Huntel Cablevision, Inc. d/b/a American Broadband Nebraska Communications, Inc. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 30, 2008. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Huntel is a corporation with its principal offices located at 1605 Washington Street, Blair, Nebraska, 68008. Huntel operates pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission May 23, 2003, under Docket C-2957 and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

In the present application, Huntel requests that the Commission enter an order approving the adoption by Huntel of the name "Huntel Cablevision, Inc. d/b/a American Broadband Nebraska Communications, Inc." Huntel has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new name. The adoption of the new name will have no effect on the rates, terms or conditions of Huntel's provision of telecommunications services to its customers. Based on the all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4001 be, and it is hereby, granted and the request of Huntel Cablevision, Inc. to change its name to Huntel Cablevision, Inc. d/b/a American Broadband Nebraska Communications, Inc. is approved.
