BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 1, 2009, an application was filed by United Telephone of the West d/b/a Embarq ("Embarq") of Lafayette, Colorado, seeking authority to do business as CenturyLink. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 3, 2009. No protests were filed; therefore, we process this application pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Embarq is a corporation with its principal offices located at 100 CenturyTel Drive, Monroe, Louisiana 71203. Embarq operates pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission April 26, 1988 under Docket C-0749 and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

In the present application, Embarq requests that the Commission enter an order approving the adoption by Embarq of the name "CenturyLink". Embarq has received authority from the Secretary of State to use the new name. The adoption of the new name will have no effect on the rates, terms or conditions of Embarq's provision of telecommunications services to its customers. Based on all the evidence adduced, the Commission is of the opinion the application is in the public interest and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-4205 be, and it is hereby, granted and the request of United Telephone of the West d/b/a Embarq is approved.
