BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 11, 2010, the Commission docketed a request by United Way of the Midlands based on requests from the Panhandle Public Health Department in Hemingford, Nebraska, the Community Action Partnership in Humbolt, Nebraska, and the United Way of the Kearney Area, Kearney, Nebraska for use of "211" as the dialing code for First Call for Help (FCFH) services in Custer, Pawnee, Banner, Kimball and Morrill Counties.

First Call for Help, a program of the United Way of Midlands Volunteer Resource Center, is a comprehensive information and referral service.

In order to proceed on this request, this docket will evaluate the public benefits of designating "211" for Custer, Pawnee, Banner, Kimball and Morrill Counties. The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter on a date later if necessary.


