

Gothenburg Housing Authority

The Gothenburg Housing Authority ("Housing Authority") is a nonprofit group that has a mission of providing adequate and affordable housing in a professional, fiscally-prudent manner that sustains families, supports community needs, and promotes economic opportunity. The Housing Authority is focusing on two of its facilities in this application, Hillcrest Apartments and Crestview Senior Housing. Hillcrest Apartments are a 40-unit public housing complex with a commons area. Hillcrest Apartments are available for anyone over the age of 62, handicapped, or disabled, and able to live independently and income eligible. Crestview Senior Housing is a 16-apartment facility that offers carefree living for the frail, elderly, handicapped and disabled persons age 62 and over. Rent is based on a tenant's personal annual adjusted income. Included with this application is a letter of support from the Gothenburg Housing Authority.

Scope of the Project

In this application, PPC proposes, in partnership with the Gothenburg Housing Authority, to increase the access and connectivity to underserved populations, such as low-income families and the elderly, living in residential housing units in Gothenburg which are managed by the Gothenburg Housing Authority. The overarching objective of this application is to improve the accessibility and connectivity in the commons area in two of the Housing Authority's low income facilities. [REDACTED]





The Gothenburg Housing Authority is partnering with Pinpoint Communications Inc for the application in your NUSF 92 Adoption Program. We are highly supportive of the initiative for improving broadband adoption for low income people.
