AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it is hereby certified that the above-named carrier has complied with all applicable provisions of Sections 75-301 to 75-322.04, R.R.S. 1943, as amended, and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and, therefore, is entitled to receive authority from the Nebraska Public Service Commission to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

IT IS CERTIFIED, that pursuant to the Commission's Order the said carrier be, and it is hereby, issued this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a common carrier by motor vehicle; subject, however, to such terms, conditions and limitations as are now, or may hereafter be, attached to the exercise of the privileges granted to the said carrier.

AND IT IS FURTHER CERTIFIED, that the transportation service to be performed by the said carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce shall be as specified below:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Household goods between Omaha and Falls City via US-73-75, serving Shubert, Stella, Barada, Verdon, Humboldt, Dawson, Salem, Rulo and Preston as off-route points.

SUPPLEMENT NO. 3

(A) SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Household goods. Regular Route Operations: Route No. 1: From Tecumseh to and from Lincoln, via NE-136 to NE-50, thence via NE-50 to junction with NE-2, thence via NE-2 to Lincoln; serving the intermediate points of Cook, Palmyra, and Bennet and the off-route points of Burr, Douglas, and Sterling. Route No. 2: From Tecumseh to and from Omaha, via NE-136 to NE-50, thence via NE-50 to US-34, thence via US-34 to US-73-75, thence via US-73-75 to Omaha. Alternate Route: Via NE-136 to US-73-75, thence via US-73-75 to Omaha; serving all intermediate points and the off-route point of Elk Creek.

(B) SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Household goods between points in Johnson County and between points within a 15-mile radius of Cook, and between points in Johnson County and said radial area, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

SUPPLEMENT NO. 4

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:
Household goods between points in Richardson, Pawnee, Johnson, Nemaha, Otoe, Cass, Sarpy, Douglas counties and the Omaha Public Power District facilities located at or near Fort Calhoun in Washington County, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska (except Washington County) over irregular routes.

SUPPLEMENT NO. 5

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:
Household goods between points in Lancaster County on the one hand, and, on the other hand, to and from points in Seward, Jefferson, and Gage counties.
