AFTER DUE INVESTIGATION, it is hereby certified that the above-named carrier has complied with all applicable provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat., Sections 75-301 to 75-322.04, (Reissue 1996), and the requirements, rules and regulations prescribed thereunder and, therefore, is entitled to receive authority from the Nebraska Public Service Commission to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a motor carrier.

IT IS CERTIFIED, that pursuant to the Commission's Order the said carrier be, and it is hereby, issued this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as evidence of the authority of the holder to engage in transportation in Nebraska intrastate commerce as a common carrier by motor vehicle; subject, however, to such terms, conditions and limitations as are now, or may hereafter be, attached to the exercise of the privileges granted to the said carrier.


AND IT IS FURTHER CERTIFIED, that the transportation service to be performed by the said carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce shall be as specified below:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Transportation of passengers and their baggage by taxicab between points in Lincoln and a twenty-five (25) mile radius thereof, including, but not limited to, the communities of Crete, Firth, Garland, Greenwood, Hallam, Milford, Panama, Seward, and Wahoo, and between points in said area on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of passengers and their baggage originating outside of Lincoln and a twenty-five (25) mile radius thereof is not authorized, except for a continuation of a trip originating in Lincoln and a twenty-five (25) mile radius thereof, and return to a destination in Lincoln and a twenty-five (25) mile radius thereof and shown on the same billing document as a continuation of the originating trip.
